Hello again sir-

Just following up on this email from yesterday with an update on our AB 2464 (Harper). Knowing that your schedule is limited, I’m happy to explain developments here and be available for any questions you may have at any time.

Tues.3/6 Update:

We had a very constructive afternoon on Tuesday of this week with Councilman Peotter in town. Meeting with 5 offices in all, he was able to add in his unique support and knowledge of our cause given that he represents the area. Those arguments are invaluable in Sacramento and certainly helped in our efforts. We met with Assemblymembers Harper,

Quirk-Silva, and O'Donnell. Additionally, we spoke with the consultant for Assembly Natural Resources Committee, Chairman Muratsuchi's Chief of Staff, and Senator Newman's Legislative Director and Chief of Staff. Each of those meetings had a targeted purpose and we met those goals including a co-author commitment from Asm. Quirk-Silva. More follow-up is needed on my end with those and other offices after which I will update accordingly.

Bill Amendment Update:

After consulting with Asm. Harper, Councilman Peotter, and Don Schmitz, we have made the decision to use a different bill of Asm. Harper's to carry the Port designation language. The current version of AB 2464 will be inserted into AB 1196. (this is a common practice termed as a "gut & amend") By using AB 1196 (Harper), our new bill will begin in the State Senate under different legislative deadlines. This will allow for additional time to gather co-authors and resolve any policy or political concerns that may arise. This amendment request has been submitted by the author's office and we expect to have language in hand the week of March 19th. AB 1196, once amended, will be referred to the new policy committee, likely Senate Natural Resources, and be eligible for a vote sometime before July depending on the committee's workload.
