Section 1: City staff shall bring forward actions to formalize recent City actions regarding providing for a better customer service experience on Newport Harbor, including but not limited to mooring administration, more active code enforcement, better harbor clean-up and maintenance, and more. This may include revisions of Title 17 of the Newport Beach Municipal Code to reflect these changes and the City's new role. A management review will be conducted to advise staff and the Council on optimal organizational structures.
